

METHODOLOGY

This institution uses the following methodology for imparting education:

It will use Integral Pedagogical Paradigm as its methodology. Integral pedagogy is based on five principles:

- a. Context: life experiences of the students become the context of the lesson.
- b. Experience: cognitive and effective knowledge of the matter.
- c. Reflection: Through reflection, the student grasps the significance of their lesson more fully which leads to a more formative and liberative process.
- d. Action: internal human growth and its external manifestation.
- e. Evaluation: to know the extent of benefit to the student.

It will use cooperative learning, rather than competitive learning as its methodology. Peer tutoring, group study etc. will help all sections of students to understand and personalise their lessons and help each other to grow.

Multiple intelligence: the institution will create an atmosphere where each student's various intelligences are taken into account and each student is helped to develop various intelligences to shine in life.

Remedial classes: this will be mainly for the socioeconomically marginalised section of society to help them to keep up with their studies.

FACILITIES LIBRARY

COMPUTER LAB

SCIENCE LABORATORIES

The College has distinct Science laboratories for practical sessions in Physics, Chemistry and Zoology. The labs are spacious and offer modern and excellent equipments where our students are encouraged to use their analytical and creative skills through research and experimentation.















NSS, NCC & AICUF

NSS, NCC & AICUF are introduced in the college as part of character formation and social service to the Nation. The college has adopted neighboring village as extension centre where the students can get first-hand experience of the lives of the underprivileged and try to do some outreach programme to the village to change the situation for better.

PERSONAL COUNSELING

Personal Counselling and Guidance are taken care by St. Xavier College. The College Management has assigned Fr. Varghese Puthussery SJ, Fr. STUDENT'S WELFARE

SCHOLARSHIP

St. Xavier's College does provide Management Scholarships for the weaker sections and deserving students.

The College also encourages students to get the scholarships offered by the Government of Jharkhand to the eligible students of SC/ST/BC.

College tries to tap some resources from various trusts, alumnae association and club in order to cater to the deserving students.

ANTI-RAGGING CELL

Ragging is strictly banned in St. Xavier's College. In order to prevent such kind of activity in campus, an anti-ragging committee has been formed. Anti-ragging notification is displayed on the college noticeboard.

The College has been conducting Anti-Ragging meeting as part of orientation in the campus. The Student Council members along with the entire entire faculty play a key role for implementing the Anti-Ragging Campaign in the campus and creating awareness on zero tolerance to anti-ragging in the campus. Anti-Ragging complaint box is available in the College campus.

The Student Council members are asked to keep a check on it and report immediately to the









Principal in case of such incidents within the College campus and in the hostels as well. The Principal has assigned staff to look into the matter very seriously.

The College has Zero-Tolerance to Ragging. Anti-Ragging Campaigns are conducted annually at the beginning of the academic year to ensure a safe and healthy environment for Freshers and the students can meet the Principal personally and convey their grievances at any time.

GRIEVANCE CELL

The College has a transparent mechanism to address the grievances of students. A Xaverian can request for a grievance remedial measure for any matter of concern.

If a student has any grievance regarding the infrastructure facilities and services offered or any other requirements the student can express it in the Student Forum Meet either through the Class Leaders or drop letters in the suggestion box. The Student Forum Meet is attended by the Student Leaders and grievances are represented to the Principal.

Grievances must contain the student's name and class and department and







a statement regarding grievance or complaint. Upon receipt of the formal grievance from the student, the Principal shall review the grievance along with the grievance redressal committee Members whether the grievance is within the limits of the Student Grievance Procedure, and assess facts if true, or not and take necessary steps to redress the grievance in time.

If the Principal determines that a complaint is genuine, timely, and a necessity, copies of the complaint will be provided to the members of the Grievance Redressal Committee, and will arrange for corrective measures. The final decision is taken by the Principal.

Attendance in all classes is compulsory. Every student is expected to be regular to classes. A student should have a minimum of 85% attendance in all classes to qualify for the examination and, scholarship and awards of any kind.

Students who have been absent on the previous day/s will not be allowed to attend classes without the permission of the Principal /HODs. Such students should fill up the 'Non-Attendance and Leave Record' chart in the diary countersigned by either of the parents / guardians, and get the signature of the Principal / HODs in order to attend the classes again.

Prior permission of the Principal / HODs is to be obtained in case of absence due to foresceable events like festivities, wedding at home, visiting ailing parents and family members, etc. All applications must be countersigned by the parents / guardians.

In case of absence, due to accident or sudden ill health of serious nature, information /application, countersigned by either of the parents, must be submitted to the Principal / HODs within three days of the occurrence. Certificate of a registered medical practioner must be submitted along with the application in such cases of sick-leave.

Regular absence or long period (10 consecutive days and more) of absence without the prior permission of the Principal / HODs would be considered serious offence and breach of discipline. Appropriate disciplinary action / remedial steps will be taken against such cases.

Prolonged period of absence lasting one calendar month and more, without the prior permission of the Principal / HODs, will be considered as the student 'having left the college' on his/her own. Transfer Certificate will be issued to students concerned in such cases.

PUNCTUALITY

Punctuality is to be maintained at all cost. Every student is expected to be Punctual to classes and, tests and examinations.

Students must be on the College premises at least 10 minutes before classes begin. College gate will be closed after the second bell and the late comers will have to go back home without attending classes.



PAYMENT OF FEES

Students are expected to pay the semester fees regularly. Before beginning the new semester all students must pay semester fee either on line (bank) or cash at the college office and keep the receipt of bank / college safely.

In case of genuine difficulty to pay the fees on time, one may seek exemption from the Principal /Secretary for a short period of time lasting not more than one month.

Fee concession will be granted to deserving students. Those who seek fee concession must submit to the Principal / Secretary an application. Final decision will be communicated to the deserving students / parents. Fee concession granted is valid only for one year and an application must be submitted for renewal in every year. However, it is made clear that no one has any claim / right for concession.

Transfer and conduct certificates will be issued to the students only on payment of all the fees and other dues to the college.

Fees once paid will not be refunded. Students, who leave the college during the course, cannot claim any portion of the fees paid.

DISCIPLINE

Classroom Discipline

Conducive atmosphere must be maintained for learning in classrooms. Strict silence must be observed.

In case a teacher is absent, students must sit quietly and study or go to the library with the approval of the Principal / HODs and use the time profitably.

Loitering around in the building during the class hours is strictly prohibited. Shouting, whistling etc. in the building is not allowed.

Respect for teachers and elders is a characteristic of a Xavierian. Honour it.





WITHIN THE CAMPUS

Register and Hindi are the medium of instruction in the College. Students who opt for writing their tests / exams in English should have sound English knowledge.

Every student must bring the Student's diary every day to the College.

All information for students is displayed either on the notice-board. Therefore, students are advised to look up the notice-board every morning on arrival and before leaving the College after the classes are over. No excuse will be considered if notices are ignored / not seen.

Parents and guardians are requested to co-operate with the college authorities educating their wards character formation, in maintaining their regularity to classes, and monitoring their progress in studies. Warning letters will be issued to students who are irregular in attendance. At the same time, parents and Guardians are advised to meet in person the Principal / HODs and the concerned class / subject teachers regarding the academic progress of their wards from time to time.

Eco-Friendly Zone:

Ecology and cleanliness in the College campus and building, protection of furniture and other things of the college should be the responsibility of every student. The college property must be protected and preserved

for lasting impact. Damage in any form such as writing / scratching, drawing on desks, walls and blackboards, breaking things, littering etc. is a highly reprehensible behaviour, and must be avoided. Violation will incur a heavy penalty, including suspension and dismissal.

Students should not leave the College premises during class-hours without the permission of the Principal /HODs.




Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in the campus.
