Masanjore Dam, also known as Pearson Dam located in the Dumka district of Jharkhand. Built on the Mayurakshi River, it is an essential resource for agriculture, flood control, and power generation. The dam was constructed in 1955 with assistance from the Canadian government and was named Pearson Dam in honor of Lester B. Pearson, a former Canadian Prime Minister. Standing 47.25 meters tall and stretching 660 meters in length, the dam creates a vast reservoir known as Masanjore Lake. The surrounding hills and forests make it a popular tourist destination.
